Friday evening, June 6 through Sunday 5 pm June 8, 2014 along the canal alongside the art center.

For this show, Mary has built a group of new pieces- small, intimate works woven primarily of hand dyed silk ribbon. The luster of the ribbon causes interesting effects as one moves through changing vantage points. Algorithmic patterning and tessellations, color, edges, and scale are explored.

Mary has long been attracted to triaxial configurations, which are widely embedded in the natural world- lattices found in crystals, "closest packing", connected to the Fibonacci series and golden proportion. For Mary, this pervasive, elegant structure unfolding is a glimpse of the divine.
